

Pax Christi Call: Please join us to vigil and rally on Saturday, January 15, 2022 at 12:00 noon, to mark the 20th year anniversary of the Guantánamo Bay prison. We will vigil in front of the Augusta National Guard Armory, at the intersection of Route 202 and Armory Street, and then process to the Capitol for the rally with speakers and closing prayer.

Our message is simple: Shutdown Guantánamo. According to the ACLU, since the prison opened in 2002, 779 prisoners have been held there, including 21 children. More than 85% of those prisoners were sold as prisoners to the U.S. for a bounty. Currently, 39 remain imprisoned – 27 held indefinitely without charge in violation of international laws.
