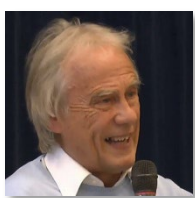
Peace & Planet's July 30 Conference has been designed to provide a forum for the world's peace movements, in order to:

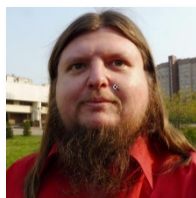

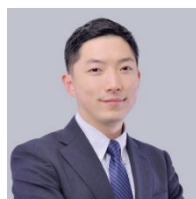
