

At noon on Friday January 22 the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons goes into effect. At that moment bells will be rung from churches around the world celebrating the beginning of the end of Nuclear Weapons. We will gather across from the Administration building at Bath Iron Works on Washington Street from 11:30 to 12:30 to witness against the continued production of the nuclear capable Aegis guided missile destroyers here at BIW by General Dynamics. The continued production of these warships undermines the spirit of this new treaty. This Treaty has been ratified by 50 nations at the United Nations and so it takes effect but sadly none of the countries with these horrible weapons plan to begin the process of Nuclear disarmament. We can speak out as clearly as possible demanding that our government ratify this treaty and end the insanity of the building of weapons of mass destruction here in Maine. Truth telling is done with love in nonviolent actions in a spirit of hope. Disarmament means turning away from warships and instead healing the many crises that surround us.
